Exchange students take classes at levels 1 to 3. Level 2 and 3 classes will require some previous study in the subject. Students are required to take a minimum of 2 classes from the Business School.

Level 4 courses are not open to exchange students.

Credits

Students can choose classes amounting to up to a maximum of 60 Strathclyde credits (equivalent to 30 ECTS credits) per semester. This usually equates to 3 classes a semester.

Students coming for one year are advised to register for 120 Strathclyde credits (equivalent to 60 ECTS credits).

Transcript of
Records

Transcripts are sent to partner universities in June/July after the exam board has finalised marks. Semester 1 grades are not finalised until the summer, and in the interim a grade report will be sent to all partners.
