# Information for CR module students regarding study plan changes for the academic year 2023-2024

The current study plans have been revised for a new two-year period. The number of changes varies between the subjects. You can either follow the current study plan in your module (for 2020-2023) or transit to the new one (for 2023-2025).

Which study plan to follow depends on how much you have already completed in the module and on your personal preferences.

If you want to complete studies next year you need to update to the 2023-2025 version **either** of the whole module, **OR** single courses, to see the teaching 2023-2024 and later register for it. Step-by-step instructions with pictures can be found <u>furthest down in this document</u>.

- New courses added to the module in the 2023-2025 version are 21045 Sustainability Reporting (Accounting), 22094 Virtual Collaboration across Cultures (Management and Organisation), and 23161 Responsible Marketing (Marketing). If you want to complete any of these courses, you need to update the module to the new version, and follow instructions to get possible completed courses included in the study plan if they are not showing automatically.
- If you are not interested in the new courses, it is most likely easiest for you to continue with the current study plan, and only update the specific courses in it. Updates **only concern courses which you have not completed** in this case.
  - Select courses you want to complete to your study plan, click on the course code to update to the 2023-2025 version of the course.
  - If the course code in your study plan ends with -E, begin by clicking the course code and switching to the code without an E via the substitution tab. Then update to the 2023-2025 version of the course.
- Updated course descriptions and teaching for the academic year 2023-2024 can only be found in the 2023-2025 versions of the courses, some descriptions have also moved, <u>please</u> <u>see more detailed instructions further down</u>.

Explanations regarding the above list:

"Not included in the module anymore, can't be completed anymore." – If you have completed this course, you can still have it in your study plan, both in the 2020-2023, and 2023-2025. You can't, however, complete it anymore if you haven't done so up to 31.7.2023, as the course either isn't offered for CR students anymore, or not offered at all.

"Changes to code \*\*\*\*\*, substitution" – The course is still given and offered to you, but if your module is in the 2020-2023 version, you first need to select the new code via substitution for the course, and then update the substituted course to the 2023-2025 version before registering for teaching. If you have changed the module to 2023-2025 and have already completed the course earlier, you can enter your course credit to the plan via the substitution from the new course code.

"No changes" – The course continues on the same code. If your module is in the 2020-2023 version, you only need to select the 2023-2025 version for the course before registering. If your module is in the 2023-2025 version, no extra steps needed before registering.

#### Step-by-step instructions for different situations

These instructions only show you *how* to complete the changes. You need to decide yourself which way around you want to update your study plan, ie. update the module, or the single courses inside it to 2023-2025.
