

The Hanken Support Foundation's travel grants spring 2026

Hanken invites personal grant applications from the following applicant groups:

Please note that applicants who have also applied for external funding for the same purpose will be prioritised if funding is limited (for more information on external funding opportunities please see <https://blogs.hanken.fi/research-funding-blog/>).

- **Researchers** working time at least 50% with permanent employment contract or fixed-term employment contract at least until the end of the activity) for the following purposes abroad (*strong motivation is required for activities outside Europe*):
 - Conferences, courses and similar activities abroad
 - Short research visits at a university or research institute abroad (maximum 3 months)
 - Other purposes for travelling abroad e.g. promoting research at Hanken

- **Doctoral researchers** (within the regular length of the doctoral programme) for the following purposes abroad (*strong motivation is required for activities outside Europe*):
 - Conferences, courses, tutorials, colloquiums and similar activities abroad
 - Research visits at a university or research institute abroad
 - Other purposes for travelling abroad within the scope of doctoral studies at Hanken

- **BSc students, MSc students and Alumni** (graduated from Hanken within the last three years) for the following purposes in European countries where German, Spanish or Portuguese are generally spoken:
 - Language courses
 - Summer & Winter Schools (for BSc and MSc students only, not alumni)
