3. Name of the register

The register of the first destination survey at Hanken School of Economics for graduates holding a master's degree.

4. The purpose of processing personal data and the register's purpose of use

The purpose of the first destination survey is to monitor the early career stages of Hanken School of Economics graduates and the labour market situation. The data collected is used in research, for the development of higher education and in student counselling, as well as to offer information to prospective students, students and graduates planning their own studies and career. The register is maintained by Hanken School of Economics.

5. Content of the register

The individualising and background data of the respondents is recorded in the register: year of graduation, student number, sex, age, nationality, first language, field of education, subject, degree level, year of selection, municipality of residence, time of graduation, place of studies, duration of enrolment, duration of presence, name, postal address, postcode, country, phone number, possible date of death, move from Finland, move date, home municipality. In terms of the respondents of the career monitoring survey the above data is complemented by the data they provide regarding their placement in working life, factors relating to the quality of employment and the satisfaction of the graduates with their studies from a perspective of working life. The individualising data of the respondent (student number, name and contact information) and the data regarding a possible date of death are used only when sending the survey and to merge the abovementioned background data.

6. Regular sources of information

Hanken School of Economics' study register and alumni database.

7. Regular transfers of disclosed data

No information transfer or surrender.







8. Regular transfers of data to countries outside the European Union or the European Economic Area

The data is not transferred outside the European Union or the European Economic Area.

9. The principles on how the data file and register is secured

The data will be kept on secure network servers and on computers of Hanken School of Economics for the duration of the data processing in locked facilities. People in charge of the material processing have a personal identifier and password that enable logging in the server. The identifiers are valid for the duration of the employment. The individualising data of the respondent will be kept in the register only until the data merge and will be destroyed after processing the data.

10. Right of inspection

The data will be used solely for scientific research and statistical purposes, so there is no right of access in accordance with Section 27(1)(3) of the Personal Data Act.
