

International Teachers' Programme (ITP) 2022 Dead-line for applications 16 May 2021

In line with the internationalisation of Hanken, faculty members are offered the opportunity to participate in the International Teachers' Programme (ITP) for the academic year 2022. Deadline for applications is 16 May 2021.

The ITP helps you to develop your teaching and innovativeness, and offers a possibility for further pedagogical training in an international environment with participants from all over the world. The program is organised by the ISBM (International Schools of Business Management), a consortium consisting of the following business schools together with the European Foundation for Management Development (EFMD):

The programme rotates between the business schools in the ISBM consortium. In 2022, INSEAD Europe Campus in Fontainebleau, France is responsible for the programme.

In the academic year 2022 the ITP consists of:

10-14 January 2022	Module 1: Virtual delivery 5 x 1/2 days
February – May 2022	An inter-modular teaching experiment
4-8 July 2022	Module 2: Residential module INSEAD Campus, France

Who can apply?

This call is for Hanken's faculty members in business and economics who are involved or will be involved in degree education and/or executive education given in English. Applicants should have permanent employment contract or a tenure track position. Applicants must be able to fully participate in both modules.

Please note that your application needs to be discussed and agreed upon with the Head of Department prior to submitting.

Hanken nominates candidates to the programme in Spring 2021. The INSEAD host makes the final decision on admission.

Funding?

Hanken funds the programme fee (accommodation and meals are included in connection with the residential modules), economy class return flight tickets to the residential modules and other costs that are within the scope of work related traveling.

How to apply?

Submit, by **16 May 2021** to stipendieombud@hanken.fi, a freely formulated short text describing in what teaching you are / have been / plan to be involved at Hanken (degree education, executive education, supervision etc.) and which parts are given in English, and which pedagogical training you have taken so far. Motivate why you are applying to the ITP and in what way your participation would benefit you and Hanken as a whole. Please attach your CV to the application.
