Registration

Please bring the following documents:

- Passport or other official photo ID

If you cannot hand in your educational document today, please bring the following tomorrow:

- Degree certificate in original
- Original academic transcript of records
- Possible official translations

Students who applied based on a degree obtained in Finland are exempted from bringing their educational documents.





At registration, you will...

- Display the above-mentioned documents for verification if you did not hand them in on Wednesday if needed
- Receive
 - Your educational documents in return
 - Hanken goodie bag
 - Certificate of enrolment (incl. your student number)
 - Hanken key
 - Public transport form for student discount (if you need one)



Only participating online on Thursday?

- If you cannot take part on site for the registration on Thursday 26.8, you need to book a separate appointment with the Admission Team in Helsinki (Helsinki students) or with the Office of Study Affairs (Vaasa students) as soon as possible. The appointment is booked through our [booking system](#) as soon as possible.
- Note that you need to choose the booking option for the study location where you are studying!



Student card

- All students registered as present are entitled to a student card (also called Frank card)
- The student card exist in the form of
 - **The Frank phone app** (recommended) or
 - **The Frank student card** which you need to order online at <https://myfrank.fi/en> if you have not already done so.
 - When the card is ready, it arrives at your home address/the Student Union's office which you will see during the Hanken tour later today.
 - You can use the certificate of enrolment that you will receive tomorrow as proof of student status e.g. in the student restaurant until you get your card.
 - Each year (or semester if you pay the student union fee per semester) you will get a new sticker on your card to indicate that you are registered as present. Stickers are available at the Student Union Office.



Electronic Transportation Card

Student discount on local transportation in the Helsinki metropolitan area

- You are entitled to student discount if you are permanently (more than two years) resident in the Helsinki region and you study full-time (at least 25 hours/week). The discount is 45 % of the regular price on season tickets only.

HSL Student discount can be used with

- **The HSL app** - recommended, since the HSL card will not offer the possibility for student discount after 31.1.2022
- **HSL card** – the only option if you do not yet have Finnish online banking with strong identification and a Finnish Social Security Number
 - Go to the HSL office where they sell the cards (at the Railway station for example) with
 - Driving license, passport or an ID card
 - The certificate of residence from the [Digital and Population Data Services Agency](#) (only foreign students – more how to receive this certificate tomorrow!)
 - Frank student card/Frank phone app/The HSL form with Hanken stamp

Course Registration

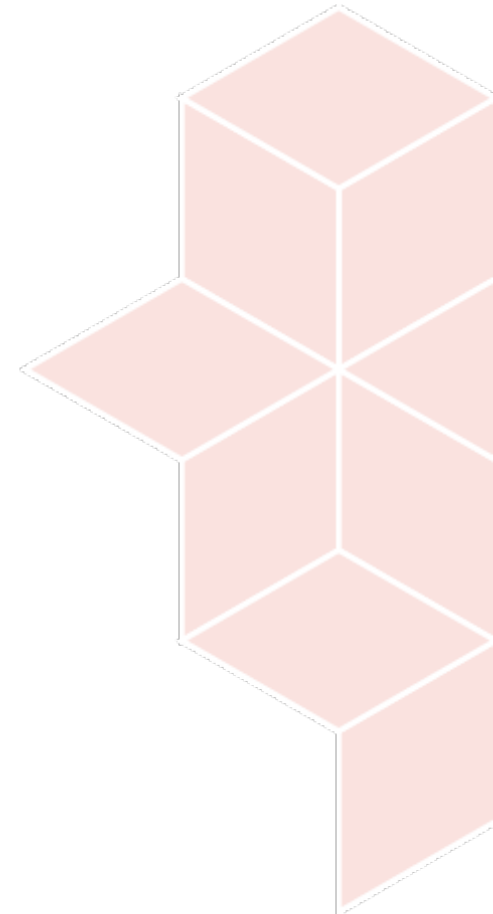
- Register for your courses and create your study plan
