Anyone can download a logo


Scammers usually only know the e-mail, not the name

Link to a login page

Anyone can claim to be IT









How to spot a scam?


- Someone contacts you unexpectedly
 - Usually by e-mail
 - Maybe impersonating someone you know or trust, or some other authority
- You have to act promptly
 - To prevent damage or avoid losing a unique opportunity
- You need to pay or provide confidential information
 - Usually your user ID and password at a fake login page













Impersonation scams




Moral of the story

 - Employees are not










Passwords



A password 101

- Passwords are personal. Period!
- At least 12 characters, complex enough.
 - Contains at least 3 of these groups: uppercase letters, lowercase letters, digits and special characters
- Create a system that helps you remember passwords, use for example phrases. "brown-coffEE@8am".







You are not allowed to use your Hanken **password** when signing up at other sites!

But it's OK to create accounts with your Hanken **e-mail** as user ID.



You signed up for notifications when emails on **hanken.fi** were pwned in a data breach and unfortunately, it's happened. Here's what's known about the breach:


Breach:	Canva
Date of breach:	24 May 2019
Accounts found:	137,272,116
Your accounts:	10
Compromised data:	Email addresses, Geographic locations, Names, Passwords, Usernames
Description:	In May 2019, the graphic design tool website <u>Canva</u> <u>suffered a data breach</u> that impacted 137 million subscribers. The exposed data included email addresses, usernames, names, cities of residence and passwords stored as bcrypt hashes for users not using social logins. The data was provided to HIBP by a source who requested it be attributed to " <u>JimScott.Sec@protonmail.com</u> ".



Students can buy F-secure virus protection for a small fee to their own computers.

A students gets

- Internet Security (or "Safe") to the following price: 1 year one computer 4,99 euro or 3 computers 9,99 euro.
- "Total" 1 year for one en apparat 15 euro or 3 computers 30 euro.


